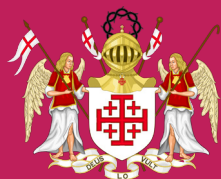

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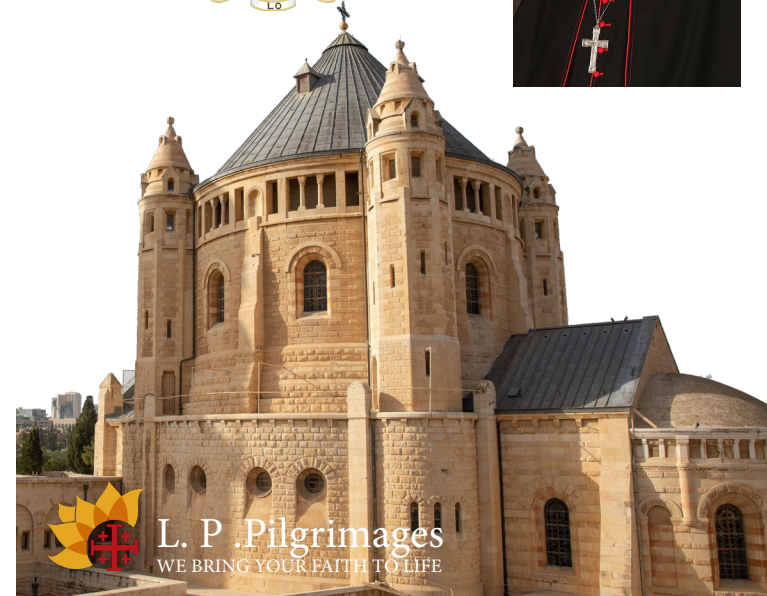
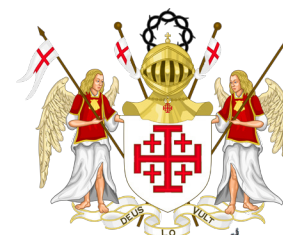

DAY 1 – DEPART USA

Depart the United States on your overnight flight to Tel Aviv. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served onboard as you begin your pilgrimage to the Holy Land, following in the footsteps of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Prepare your heart for a grace-filled journey through Galilee, Bethlehem, and Jerusalem, where the Gospel comes alive at every sacred site.

DAY 2 – ARRIVE TEL AVIV • NAZARETH

Upon arrival at Tel Aviv Airport, meet your pilgrimage guide and travel north through the beautiful countryside to Nazareth, the hometown of Jesus. Celebrate your first Holy Mass in the Holy Land at the Holy Family Church of the Sisters of Nazareth (subject to arrival time). Settle into your hotel and enjoy your first evening in the city where the Holy Family lived and where the mystery of the Incarnation unfolded.

Dinner and overnight at the Legacy Hotel Nazareth.

DAY 3 – CANA • MOUNT TABOR

This morning we travel to Cana of Galilee, where Jesus performed His first public miracle by changing water into wine at the wedding feast. Celebrate Holy Mass with the Renewal of Marriage Vows, a moving experience for married couples and an opportunity for all pilgrims to reflect upon the Sacrament of Marriage. Continue to Mount Tabor, the traditional site of the Transfiguration, where Christ revealed His divine glory before Peter, James, and John. Spend time in prayer while enjoying spectacular views over the Jezreel Valley before returning to Nazareth.

Dinner and overnight at the Legacy Hotel Nazareth.

DAY 4 – MOUNT OF BEATITUDES • TABGHA • CAPERNAUM • SEA OF GALILEE

Celebrate Holy Mass at the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus proclaimed the Sermon on the Mount and taught the Beatitudes overlooking the peaceful waters of the Sea of Galilee. Continue to Tabgha to visit the Church of the Multiplication of the Loaves and Fishes and the Church of the Primacy of Saint Peter, where the Risen Lord entrusted Peter with the care of His Church.

Visit Capernaum, often called the “Town of Jesus,” where He preached, healed the sick, and called His disciples.

Explore the remains of Saint Peter’s house and the ancient synagogue. This afternoon, enjoy a peaceful boat ride across the Sea of Galilee before visiting the famous 2,000-year-old “Jesus Boat” discovered near Magdala.

Dinner and overnight at the Legacy Hotel Nazareth.

DAY 5 – CAESAREA MARITIMA • MOUNT CARMEL • NAZARETH

Travel to Caesarea Maritima, the magnificent Roman city built by King Herod the Great. Here St. Peter baptized Cornelius, the first Gentile convert, and St. Paul was imprisoned before beginning his final journey to Rome. Explore the impressive archaeological remains, including the Roman Theatre and the Palace of Pontius Pilate overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. Continue to Mount Carmel to celebrate Holy Mass at the mountain forever associated with the Prophet Elijah. Return to Nazareth to visit the Basilica of the Annunciation, built over the home of the Blessed Virgin Mary, followed by Saint Joseph’s Church and Mary’s Well. Dinner and overnight at the Legacy Hotel Nazareth.

DAY 6 – TAYBEH • JORDAN RIVER • JERICHO • DEAD SEA • JERUSALEM

Depart Nazareth and journey south to Taybeh, the last entirely Christian village in the Holy Land. Celebrate Holy Mass before continuing to the Jordan River at Kasr El-Yahud, the traditional site of the Baptism of Jesus, where pilgrims renew their Baptismal Promises. Continue to Jericho, the oldest continually inhabited city in the world. View the Mount of Temptation, where Jesus fasted for forty days, and see the traditional Sycamore Tree associated with Zacchaeus. Later, enjoy the unique experience of floating in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea before ascending through the Judean Desert to Jerusalem, the Holy City. Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

DAY 7 – BETHLEHEM • EIN KAREM

Today we journey to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Our Savior. Celebrate Holy Mass at Saint Catherine’s Church before visiting the Basilica of the Nativity and descending into the Grotto where Jesus Christ was born. Continue to Saint Jerome’s Grotto and other chapels within the basilica complex before visiting Beit Sahour and the Shepherds’ Fields, where the angels announced Christ’s birth to the shepherds. Visit the Seminary in Beit Jala before continuing to Ein Karem, birthplace of Saint John the Baptist and the site of the Visitation, where Mary greeted her cousin Elizabeth. Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

DAY 8 – MOUNT OF OLIVES • GETHSEMANE • JERUSALEM

Begin the day atop the Mount of Olives with a breathtaking panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Church of the Pater Noster before walking the traditional Palm Sunday route to

Dominus Flevit, where Jesus wept over the Holy City. Continue to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Basilica of the Agony, where Our Lord prayed before His Passion. Celebrate Holy Mass in this sacred place and spend time in quiet reflection among the ancient olive trees. Later, visit the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem before making a solemn entrance into the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre, the holiest shrine in Christianity. Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

DAY 9 – BEIT SAHOUR • BETHLEHEM UNIVERSITY • MOUNT ZION

Visit the Latin Patriarchate School in Beit Sahour and meet members of the local Christian community. Continue to Bethlehem University to learn about the Church’s educational mission in the Holy Land.

This afternoon, visit Mount Zion, beginning at Dormition Abbey, which commemorates the Dormition of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Continue to the Cenacle, the traditional site of the Last Supper, the institution of the Holy Eucharist, and Pentecost.

Conclude the day at Saint Peter in Gallicantu, built over the traditional house of Caiaphas, where Jesus was imprisoned before His Crucifixion and where Peter denied knowing the Lord. Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

DAY 10 – JERUSALEM • THE PASSION OF OUR LORD

Early this morning, prayerfully walk the Via Dolorosa while meditating on the Stations of the Cross. Celebrate Holy Mass at the Basilica of the Holy Sepulchre before visiting Calvary and the Empty Tomb of Christ. Continue to Saint Anne’s Church and the nearby Pools of Bethesda before visiting the Antonia Fortress, traditionally identified as the Praetorium where Jesus was condemned by Pontius Pilate. Walk through the Old City’s Jewish Quarter for views of the Western Wall, the Dome of the Rock, and Al-Aqsa Mosque. The remainder of the afternoon offers time for personal prayer, reflection, or private visits within the Old City before gathering for your farewell dinner.

Dinner and overnight at the Notre Dame of Jerusalem Center.

DAY 11 – RETURN TO USA

Transfer to Tel Aviv Airport for your return flight to the United States. As your pilgrimage comes to a close, carry home unforgettable memories, renewed faith, lasting friendships, and the many spiritual blessings received while walking in the footsteps of Jesus throughout the Holy Land.
